**CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER**

Council Vice President Bromberg called the meeting to order at 8:00pm in the Council Chambers located at 406 Rivervale Road, River Vale, New Jersey 07675.

**MAYOR’S COMMENTS**

The Mayor opened with comments regarding the recent street fair in River Vale. The Mayor thanked Paul Greco and Elisa Martin for planning and organizing the event; as well as the CERT Team members for all their hard work. The street fair drew people to the downtown area and was very well done being it was the first time. The Mayor said it will get better.

Mayor Blundo announced that the High School referendum vote is tomorrow. The polls are open from 2:00 to 9:00pm. The Mayor explained that the vote would be to change the funding formula to a per student formula. The Mayor stated that we need to send a message to Montvale and Woodcliff Lake.

The Mayor commented on the Golf Course and that he does believe the Township can run the course and make a profit; it will be a big benefit to the town.

**COUNCIL COMMENTS**

Councilman de Stefan announced that the Library received a Silver Award for design; this is a great award and honor. He thanked Ann McCarthy, Bob Gallione, the Mayor and his colleagues for their support.

Councilman Matos had no comments.

Councilwoman Sieg reported that she had the pleasure of attending the grand opening of River Vale Physical Therapy. She stated that it was nice to see a more diverse business in town. Councilwoman Sieg also had the pleasure of attending the Sidewalk Sale and agreed with the Mayor that the response was great for the first time. She concluded that Resident’s for a Better River Vale held a 50/50 raffle during the sidewalk sale and the funds raised will benefit COTA.

The Mayor took this opportunity to announce that Linda Wayne is being named Volunteer of the Year. The Mayor stated that Linda has been a resident for 36 years and has volunteered for countless organizations. He listed the cub scouts, the Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary, coordination of the parades, Cert Team member and a member of the Board of Health. Mayor Blundo added that he is very proud and Mrs. Wayne will receive her recognition from the County Executive within the next few months.

Council Vice President Bromberg stated that we are very fortunate to have such a great community. He specifically noted the Library Board of Trustees which is comprised of volunteers which worked together and made it possible for the funds to be available to do the Capital Improvement. Councilman Bromberg offered congratulations on the sidewalk sale all the volunteers that worked. Council Vice President announced that the Oktoberfest is scheduled for October 3<sup>rd</sup>. He commended Linda Wayne; both she and her family do a great for the community. Councilman Bromberg also congratulated the both of the Baseball teams.

**Business Administrator’s Report**

Mr. Gallione announced the there will be 5K run/walk in honor of J.G. Blackgrove. He added that the Farmers Market will continue to run through October. The Flu shots are being given on November 3<sup>rd</sup> from 10:00 to 12:00pm at the Community Center. Mr. Gallione continued that November 1<sup>st</sup> is the deadline for the senior freeze.

**Township Engineer’s Report**

Mr. Statile reported that the 2010 Road Program is complete and the Bikeway restoration is about half complete. The DPW remediation project is also about half complete. Mr. Statile reported that the EMS design work is near completion and the preconstruction meeting for the sidewalk work is scheduled for this Thursday.

The Engineer announced that they will be rejecting the bids for the Roberge Field Improvement project because they were over budget; the project will be rebid. He also gave an update of the County resurfacing of both Westwood Avenue and Prospect Avenue to the Park Ridge border. Mr. Statile concluded that the 7-Eleven will be open with in the next two weeks.

Councilman de Stefan asked if it was possible to get a grant to extend the bank stabilization project; he stressed that it’s a project that must get done.

**HEARING OF THE PUBLIC**

Motion by Councilman Matos; seconded by Councilman de Stefan to open the meeting to the public.

Council Vice President Bromberg read the following statement into the record.

All member of the public are expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner. Any derogatory, abusive or threatening statements will not be permitted. The Chair will immediately rule such conduct out of order and terminate any further comments.”*

James Caltabellatta – 140 Rivervale Road—commented on the Bonnabel property and the possibility of the County purchasing his property to be retained as a walking path. He requested that the Township comply with the wishes of the residents and help the County expedite the purchase.

Joe Massin – 68 Holiday Court – commented on the Golf Course and the possible substantial loss of tax revenue. Mr. Massin also commented on the creation of an ordinance to establish the utility before the resolution. He added that he is concerned about the utility debt.

The Mayor answered that we want to do everything transparently and we are following the instructions of our Bond Counsel and Auditors.

Bob Fortsch – 511 Bernita Drive – commended the Police Department on the phenomenal job they did finding a hit and run driver. Mr. Fortsch encouraged people to vote and attend the upcoming police golf outing that will benefit a River Vale police officer’s sick child. All the proceeds will go to help with the medical expenses.

George Dalcero—136 Rivervale Road –commented on the flooding on Rivervale Road near Tiffany Avenue because of there being no curbing. He added that the County has been unresponsive.

Mayor Blundo asked the engineer to look into Mr. Dalcero’s concerns.

Karen Jones – 110 Sloat Place – supports the County purchasing the Bonnabel property.

Jim Briscoe – 772 Tiffany Avenue – had questions regarding a wetlands issue and the developer being allowed to fill in to build.

2. That, in the event of a County Trust Fund award that may be less than the grant amount requested above, the applicant has, or will secure, the balance of funding necessary to complete the project, or modify the project as necessary; and,
3. That the applicant agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations in its performance of the project; and,
4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
