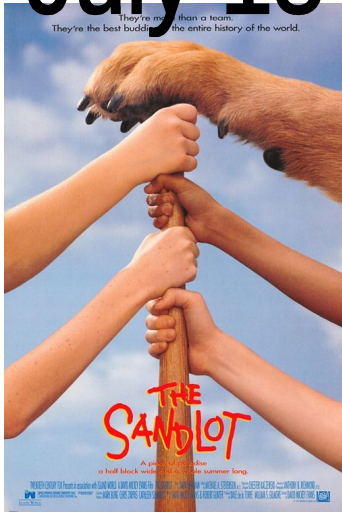

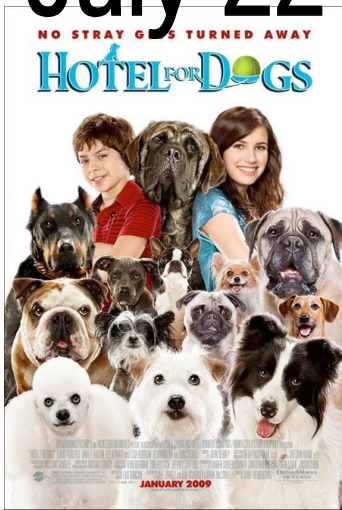
## The Sandlot
