SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the federally funded Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program strives to empower communities to make walking and bicycling to school a safe and routine activity by making funding available for a wide variety of projects and activities that support and encourage students to walk and bicycle to school; and

WHEREAS, in New Jersey, these funds are available through and administered by the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) and can be used to fund a variety of both infrastructure and non-infrastructure projects that benefit elementary and middle school children in grades K-8, both public and private schools; and

WHEREAS, the government of the Township of River Vale has worked closely with the River Vale School District on making safety improvements along the routes to the Woodside Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, in partnership with the River Vale School District, the Township of River Vale intends to apply to the New Jersey Safe Routes to School Program for funding to support infrastructure and non-infrastructure projects in accordance with the program requirements and as detailed in said application;

WHEREAS, the Township of River Vale desires to receive \$482,100 in funds from the New Jersey Department of Transportation SRTS Program for the purpose of making pedestrian/biking safety improvements along routes to the Woodside Elementary School; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application SRS-2022-Woodside School Regional Safety Imp-00027 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the Township of River Vale.

**RESOLUTION TO TEMPORARILY WAIVE BUILDING PERMIT FEES
FOR FLOOD DAMAGE REPAIRS FROM TROPICAL STORM IDA**

WHEREAS, in the evening hours of September 1, 2021 the Township of River Vale encountered unprecedented flooding caused by Tropical Storm Ida; and,

WHEREAS, on September 6, 2021 Governor Murphy declared a FEMA Major Disaster Declaration in six Counties; including Bergen County, impacted by Tropical Storm Ida; and,

WHEREAS, the Township recognizes the need to expedite and process permits necessary for the safe and secure return of its residents to their homes; and,

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey under the New Jersey Uniform Construction Code at N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.19(b)5 provides that no fee shall be collected for work consequential to a natural disaster when the local code enforcement agency is waiving its fee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of River Vale has agreed to waive all constructions permit fees within its jurisdiction associated with the issuance of the required permits for work directly associated with the flood damage caused from Tropical Storm Ida through November 1, 2021.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVER VALE, COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 212 OF THE CODE ENTITLED “STORMWATER MANAGEMENT”

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of River Vale that Chapter 212 of the Township Code entitled “Stormwater Management” is hereby amended as follows:

§ 212-2. Definitions.

COUNTY REVIEW AGENCY

An agency designated by the County Board of ~~Chosen Freeholders~~ **Commissioners** to review municipal stormwater management plans and implementing ordinance(s). The county review agency may either be:

- (1) A county planning agency; or
- (2) A county water resource association created under N.J.S.A 58:16A-55.5, if the ordinance or resolution delegates authority to approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove municipal stormwater management plans and implementing ordinances.

NEW JERSEY STORMWATER BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES (BMP) MANUAL or BMP MANUAL

The manual maintained by the Department providing, in part, design specifications, removal rates, calculation methods, and soil testing procedures approved by the Department as being capable of contributing to the achievement of the stormwater management standards specified in this chapter. The BMP Manual is periodically amended by the Department as necessary to provide design specifications on additional best management practices and new information on already included practices reflecting the best available current information regarding the particular practice and the Department's determination as to the ability of that best management practice to contribute to

compliance with the standards contained in this chapter. Alternative stormwater management measures, removal rates, or calculation methods may be utilized, subject to any limitations specified in this chapter, provided the design engineer demonstrates to the municipality, in accordance with §212-~~5~~ ~~4~~^F, of this chapter and N.J.A.C. 7:8-5.2(g), that the proposed measure and its design will contribute to achievement of the design and performance standards established by this chapter.

§ 212-4.C. Stormwater management requirements for major development.

The following linear development projects are exempt from the groundwater recharge, stormwater runoff quality, and stormwater runoff quantity requirements of § 212-~~5~~ ~~4~~^{P, Q and R}:

- (1) The construction of an underground utility line, provided that the disturbed areas are revegetated upon completion;
- (2) The construction of an aboveground utility line, provided that the existing conditions are maintained to the maximum extent practicable; and
- (3) The construction of a public pedestrian access, such as a sidewalk or trail with a maximum width of 14 feet, provided that the access is made of permeable material.

§ 212-9.A. (3) Requirements for a site development stormwater plan.

The applicant shall submit ⁵ copies of the materials listed in the Checklist for Site Development Stormwater Plans in accordance with Subsection **I(3)** of this section.

This Ordinance shall take effect following adoption and approval in a time and manner prescribed by law.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVER VALE, COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 33 OF THE CODE ENTITLED “POLICE DEPARTMENT” SECTION 8 “PROMOTIONS”

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of River Vale that Chapter 90 of the Township Code Section 33-8 entitled “Promotions” is hereby amended as follows:

§ 33-8. Promotions.

Add New Section

K. Review of Process.

1. Within ten (10) days of the publishing of the promotional list, a candidate may file a written letter requesting a review of that candidate’s file related to that specific promotional process. Said letter must contain the reason(s) or justification(s) for the request and must be submitted to the Mayor and the Chief of Police. The Mayor will review the request. The review request may include:
 - a. Review and re-tabulation of the scored elements of the promotional process related to the requesting candidate.
 - b. Review of any evaluation, or internal document that was used in the promotional process related to the requesting candidate.
2. If the review warrants a change to the results of the promotional ranking, which determination shall be within the Mayor’s sole discretion, the candidate ranking shall be re-evaluated.

This Ordinance shall take effect following adoption and approval in a time and manner prescribed by law.

REFUNDING BOND ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVER VALE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE REFUNDING OF CERTAIN GENERAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS, SERIES 2011, OF THE TOWNSHIP AND APPROPRIATING AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$2,130,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$2,130,000 REFUNDING BONDS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVER VALE FOR FINANCING THE COST THEREOF

THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVER VALE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, DO ORDAIN (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) **AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Township of River Vale, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the “Township”), is hereby authorized to refund all or a part of the Township’s General Improvement Bonds, Series 2011, dated June 20, 2007, maturing on August 15 in the years 2022 to 2027, both inclusive, in the aggregate principal amount of \$2,035,000, such General Improvement Bonds being subject to redemption in whole or in part on any date on or after August 15, 2021, at a redemption price of 100% of the principal amount redeemed, plus accrued interest to the redemption date.

Section 2. In order to finance the cost of the purpose described in Section 1 hereof, negotiable refunding bonds are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount not to exceed \$2,130,000 pursuant to the Local Bond Law.

Section 3. An aggregate amount not exceeding \$100,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-51(b) has been included in the aggregate principal amount of refunding bonds authorized herein.

Section 4. The purpose of the refunding is to provide for savings in the debt service payable by the Township with respect to its outstanding obligations.

Section 5. The full faith and credit of the Township are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this refunding bond ordinance. The obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Township, and the Township shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Township for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

Section 6. This refunding bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
