Dear River Vale Residents,

Governor Phil Murphy recently signed Executive Order No. 133, reopening state parks and golf courses, and restoring the authority of county governments to determine whether county parks will be open or closed. The order takes effect at sunrise on Saturday, May 2. I am therefore pleased to open River Vale's parks and the Poplar Road Nature Sanctuary to the public for passive recreation, including walking, running, jogging and biking. Picnic areas, playgrounds, tennis and basketball courts, pavilions, restrooms, and other buildings and facilities, such as the River Vale Senior/Community Center shall remain closed at this time.

Social distancing is still required, except with immediate family members, caretakers, household members, or romantic partners. Organized or contact activities, sports, picnics and gatherings of any kind continue to be banned, per the Executive Order.
