I want to make you aware of two options for Bergen County residents who wish to be tested for COVID-19, including residents who are not currently showing symptoms. The Bergen New Bridge Medical Center testing center is by appointment only. The Bergen Community College testing center is first-come, first-served. Additional details are outlined below.

Bergen New Bridge Medical Center

Symptomatic and Asymptomatic Testing by Appointment Only. The Screening Surveys are open from 8 am – 3 pm, 7 days-a-week. Community-Based Testing Sites are for current New Jersey residents and members of New Jersey law enforcement agencies. In order to be eligible for testing, individuals must be current New Jersey residents.

Effective Sunday, May 3, 2020, exhibiting symptoms is no longer a prerequisite for testing. However, the highest priority for testing will be given to health care workers and workers in congregate living settings, and symptomatic first responders, as well as to asymptomatic NJ residents who have been in close contact with someone else who has tested positive.

This site is open on Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Each day the site is open, staff will be able to test 500 people starting at 8 a.m. This is a drive-thru testing site at Lot C of main campus and is expected to be available through May 31, 2020.
