Dear River Vale Residents,

I am encouraged as I let you know that the rate of newly confirmed Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases continues to level off here in River Vale. As we cautiously move forward, I am pleased to expand on the opening of our parks earlier in the month by re-opening our ballfields and tennis court beginning 9:00 am, Friday, May 15th. The basketball courts, playgrounds and other Township buildings remain closed at this time.

Our fields may be used by immediate family/household members only and social distancing guidelines must be followed at all times. Any type of organized or team activities including practices, games or training are still banned. Tennis games must be played as singles only. The fields and tennis court will remain open only under these circumstances.

As a reminder, although Town Hall remains closed to the public, the entry foyer/vestibule at the Town Hall entrance facing Rivervale Road is open 24 hours / 7 days a week. Inside, you can drop off property tax and other payments in the secured lock box on the door. There are also bins available to pick up and drop off building permit paperwork, Senior Freeze / PTR forms, records requests, tax appeals and more.
